There was discussion of conditions that need to be added.

There was discussion of talking with the law enforcement to see if they have the ability to be sufficiently staffed. There was discussion of the need of homeland security.

There was discussion of adding a condition for animal fencing.

Commissioner Demar Iverson was excused at 2:10 pm.

There was discussion of having a traffic/road agreement to update and maintain the roads during construction. The Commission would like to require a traffic report to help prepare the roads for construction portion.

There was discussion of the Commissions reasonable conditions that are authorized for approval in 10-8-5.

There was discussion on having a reclamation plan in place.

There was discussion on reviewing the ground water permits to see if it needs to be regulated further by the Commission.

There was discussion of having comments from the School Board, Sheriff and Hospital personal to see if they will be equipped during the construction portion of the project.

The Commissioner discussed adding a condition to comply with monitoring and reporting on a timely base.
