

QUALIFICATIONS

Before the filing officer accepts any declaration of candidacy, the filing officer shall read to the candidate the constitutional and statutory requirements for candidacy, and the candidate shall state whether he/she fulfills the requirements. If the candidate indicates that he/she does not qualify, the filing officer may not accept his/her declaration of candidacy (Utah Code Section 20A-9-201, 202).

COUNTY ATTORNEY

Utah Code 17-16-1; 17-18A-302

- An attorney licensed to practice law in Utah who is an active member in good standing of the Utah State Bar.
- A US Citizen and a registered voter in the county.
- A current resident of the county in which the person is seeking office and either has been a resident of that county for at least one year or was appointed and is currently serving as county attorney.
- Not convicted of a felony*
- Pay filing fee of **\$613.51**

COUNTY CLERK, AUDITOR

Utah Code 17-16-1

- A US Citizen and a registered voter in the county.
- At least one year resident of the county immediately before the date of the election.
- Not convicted of a felony*
- Pay filing fee of **\$410.41**

COUNTY COMMISSIONER

Utah Code 17-16-1; 17-53-202

- Registered voter for at least one year before the date of the election
- Be a US Citizen and a registered voter of the county which the member represents
- At least one year resident of the county immediately before the date of the election
- Not convicted of a felony*
- Pay filing fee of **\$259.94**

COUNTY SHERIFF

Utah Code 17-16-1; 17-22-1.5

- A US Citizen and a registered voter in the county.
- At least one year resident of the county immediately before the date of the election; and
- At the time of filing has successfully met the requirements of the Peace office Training and Certification Act; or
- Has passed a certification examination and be qualified to be certified as defined in Section 53-13-103.
- Present a POST certification with the declaration of candidacy;
- Not convicted of a felony*
- Pay filing fee of **\$477.81**

See additional requirements defined in Section 17-22-1.5(2)

*A person convicted of a felony loses the right to hold office until (1) all felony convictions have been expunged, OR (2) ten years have passed since the most recent felony conviction AND the person has paid all court-ordered restitution and fines AND the person has completed probation, been granted parole, or completed the term of incarceration associated with the felony.
