## 2023 PERSONAL PROPERTY NOTICE

## Please read before proceeding with this packet.

Enclosed is your 2023 Personal Property Tax Signed Statement. Our records show you either operated a business located within Millard County, or own personal property located within Millard County. This Signed Statement includes a listing of all equipment you have previously filed. This Signed Statement will need to be completed and returned to the Millard County Assessor's office **postmarked no later than September 4, 2023.** 

If the value of your business personal property is less than \$27,000 <u>YOU MAY</u> <u>BE EXEMPT.</u>

If the Signed Statement is not completed and returned by the September 4<sup>th</sup> due date you will not qualify for the exemption.

If the statement is not completed and returned Utah State Law requires that we estimate the value of your property. The valued cannot be appealed. There will also be a penalty of 10% of the estimated amount, but not less than \$27.000 (Utah code 59-2-307).

If you close your business prior to January 1, 2023, please complete and return the gold-colored Business Closure Form along with your signed statement. Failure to file this form before the deadline will also result in the same estimated value and penalty.
