By _____, Phone _____ in Millard County is hereby granted, subject to the Regulations for the Control and Protection of State Highway Rights-of-Way, Standard Specifications for Bridge Construction, Specifications for Excavation on State Highways, General Safety Orders of the Industrial Commission, Safety Manual for Road Bridge Construction, Instructions to Flagmen, the approved plans, and any special limitations set forth herein, permission for the purpose _____

The work permitted herewith shall commence on _____, 20____ and shall be completed and all disturbed surfaces or objects restored on or before _____, 20____. In the event work is commenced under this permit, the applicant agrees to prosecute the same to completion by the date herein above specified. In the event the applicant fails or refuses to complete the work the Millard County Road Department may, at its election, fill in or otherwise correct any existing impediments at the expense of the subject to immediate payment by the applicant.

Applicant shall execute a bond in the minimum amount of \$1000.00, increased by multiples thereof as determined by the County Road Supervisor or his duly authorized representative, to insure faithful performance of the permittee's obligation. The bond shall remain in force for three years after completion of the work.

Before work permitted herewith is commenced, the applicant shall notify: Millard County Road Department at (435) 864-2467 and commencement of said work is understood to indicate that the applicant will comply with all instructions and regulations of the Millard County Road Department with respect to performance of said work, and that he will properly safeguard said work to prevent accident and shall indemnify and hold harmless Millard County from all damages arising out of any and all operations performed under this Permit.

If applicant fails to comply with Millard County Road Department regulations, specifications, or instructions pertinent to this permit, the County Supervisor or his duly authorized representative may by verbal order suspend the work until the violation is corrected. If the applicant fails or refuses to comply promptly, the County Road Supervisor or his authorized representative may issue a written order stopping all or any part of the work. When satisfactory corrective action is taken an order permitting resumption of work may be issued.
